NOTICE TO CONSULTANTS FOR 198TH AVENUE ROAD PRESERVATION

The City of Bonney Lake solicits interest from consulting firms with expertise in Civil Engineering Design. This agreement will be for approximately three months in duration with the option for the City of Bonney Lake to extend it for additional time and money if necessary. Consultants will be considered for the following project. The City of Bonney Lake reserves the right to amend terms of this "Request for Qualifications" (RFQ) to circulate various addenda, or to withdraw the RFQ at any time, regardless of how much time and effort consultants have spent on their responses.

Project Description: The work to be performed by the CONSULTANT consists of preparing Plans, Specifications, and Engineering documents for an asphalt overlay to 198th Avenue East from SR 410 to Sumner Buckley Highway. The proposed improvement is a road preservation effort that may include some minor asphalt repair, survey monument restoration, asphalt overlay, and road and channelization striping. This project has a mandatory (0)% DBE goal. The major feature of the project will be the design documents for an asphalt overlay for a two lane road approximately 0.2 miles in length. The City of Bonney Lake reserves the right to retain the services of the successful firm(s) for any subsequent phases (CN) associated with this project.

Evaluation Criteria: Submittals will be evaluated and ranked based on the following criteria:

- 1) Qualification of Proposed Project Manager
- 2) Qualifications/Expertise of Firm
- 3) Ability to meet schedule
- 4) Approach to project
- 5) Familiarity with WSDOT/FHWA standards
- 6) Past Performance/References

Submittal: Submittals should include the following information: Firm name, phone and fax numbers; Name of Principal-in-Charge and Project Manager; and Number of employees in each firm proposed to project.
